**Where: This is an online event via Zoom.**

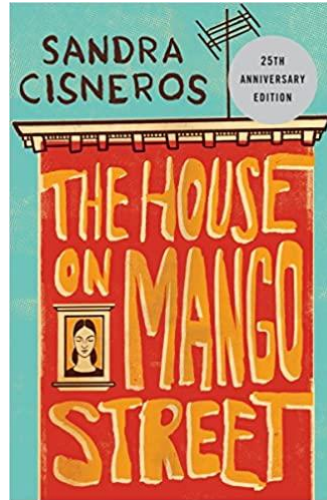
### Details
